

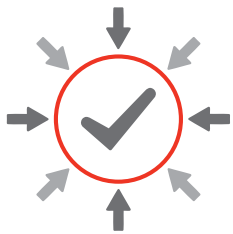
RESPECTFUL SPEECHES

When sharing your ideas, perspectives and stories, please consider the following guidelines:

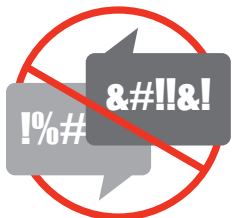


Positive Impact
